OUR TOP PRIORITY IS THE SAFETY OF OUR PASSENGERS AND EMPLOYEES

We are fully aware that the progression of the coronavirus (COVID-19) raises questions for our passengers. Our team is closely monitoring the development of the situation. We are taking all necessary measures to allow you to continue traveling in complete safety and peace of mind.

Out of respect for all passengers and employees, we ask you to respect the hygiene rules prescribed by Health PEI, New Brunswick Department of Health, and Nova Scotia Health.

MEASURES TAKEN BY MARITIME BUS

- Maximum capacity has been reduced to 50% on all vehicles. We ask you to maintain a minimum distance of one seat between each passenger.
- Extra steps are taken to ensure the cleanliness of our fleet.
- Masks may be required if a passenger shows any cold or flu symptoms.
- Passengers with clear symptoms associated with COVID-19 will be denied boarding to protect everyone's health. In this case tickets will be 100% refundable, credited, or changeable.

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
